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RESOLUTION NUMBER 23-2008

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORTERVILLE
ADOPTING THE PORTERVILLE URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT
PLAN 2007 UPDATE

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of California Urban Water Management Planning Act, adopted with the passage of Assembly Bill 797 in 1983, and contained in the California Government Code Sections 10610 – 10656, require the City of Porterville to adopt an Urban Water Management Plan to guide the long-term use of water in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, utilizing the services of a planning consulting firm retained for this purpose, held a public hearing on December 12, 2006 to discuss water management issues and the Urban Water Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, many local water agencies were involved in the preparation of the Urban Water Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2007, City Staff presented the recommended draft Urban Water Management Plan to the City Council for the purpose of gathering public input; and

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2008, City Staff presented the recommended draft Urban Water Management Plan to the City Council again for the purpose of gathering public input; and


WHEREAS, the Porterville City Council, on March 4, 2008, conducted a duly noticed and properly advertised public hearing to take public testimony and to consider additional revisions to the final draft of the Urban Water Management Plan and adopted the Urban Water Management Plan as presented; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has independently reviewed and evaluated the Environmental circumstances specifically evaluated in the EIR for the Porterville 2030 General Plan and Urban Water Management Plan and is convinced that the Selected Alternative incorporates policies and implementation measures that will substantially lessen and avoid many significant environmental effects associated with the Plan, although several of these effects will remain significant and unavoidable despite the General Plan policies designed to mitigate these impacts to the extent feasible; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, on March 4, 2008, completed its deliberations and adopted all appropriate and necessary CEQA Findings of Fact, including a Statement of Overriding Considerations, to substantiate and document its decision to adopt the Urban Water Management Plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:
