WHAT GOES INTO MY BLUE CAN?

All common household recyclables are accepted:



ALL PLASTICS #1-#7

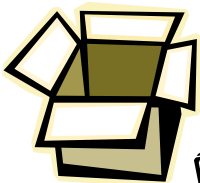
beverage containers, shampoo bottles, detergent bottles, grocery bags, milk jugs

ALL GLASS JARS & BOTTLES - beverages, wine, condiment



ALL STEEL/TIN CANS - soup, fruit and vegetable, pet food

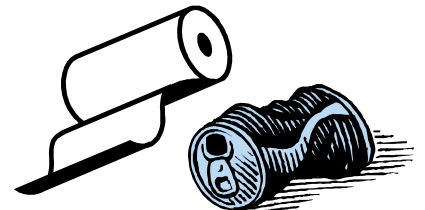
ALL PAPER - newspaper, junk mail, office/school papers, magazines, grocery bags, telephone books, catalogs, computer paper, file folders, construction paper



BOXES - cardboard shipping and packing materials, cereal and other dry food boxes, shoe boxes, gift boxes



ALUMINUM - cans, scrap, clean foil



WHAT SHOULDN'T GO IN MY BLUE CAN?

Food scraps

Clothing/fabric

Shoes

Styrofoam

Used Paper Products (paper towels, plates, etc.)

Candy wrappers/chip bags/cookie bags

Light bulbs, mirrors, window glass

Foil pouches/juice boxes

Porcelain, china, ceramics
