If the county superintendent of education is appointed, then the appointment made pursuant to this paragraph shall be made by the county board of education.</p> <p>(5) One member appointed by the Chancellor of the California Community Colleges to represent community college districts in the county.</p> <p>(6) One member of the public appointed by the county board of supervisors.</p> <p>(7) One member representing the employees of the former redevelopment agency appointed by the mayor or chair of the board of supervisors, as the case may be, from the recognized employee organization representing the largest number of former redevelopment agency employees employed by the successor agency at that time. In the case where city or county employees performed administrative duties of the former redevelopment agency, the appointment shall be made from the recognized employee organization representing those employees. If a recognized employee organization does not exist for either the employees of the former redevelopment agency or the city or county employees performing administrative duties of the former redevelopment agency, the appointment shall be made from among the employees of the successor agency.
